



Drawing the "Nomenclátor" of geo-historical and morphological small statistical units in Spain: methodology and relationships with grid statistics.

Abstract

The aim is a general presentation of Spanish statistical system of small statistical units below municipalities, focusing in the branch of statistical units call "Nomenclator", that describe geo-historical entities at two levels and a third level for identifying the morphological urban continuous. There are not defined boundaries of these statistical units, instead the system starts at the end of XVIII century and was adopted for all the publications figures in all Census from 1857 onwards. The current project is to built a clear and geographical consistent set of current units, considering the complex crossroad of available information, institutional actors and users needs. Draft road map and methodological issues will be presented. Relationships with grid statistical will be also considered.
