Project Workshop in Vienna postponed

The workshop in Vienna planned for May 2020 has now been postponed to May 2021. This is because it is not likely possible to travel this year.

This may cause challenges for participants with the resource allocations. It may not be possible to reassign resources to next year. It was discussed would it be possible to reassign resources from travels that have not been realized. Nikos pointed out that if this affects on some results, a change to project agreement should be made. This should be inquired from Eurostat.

It was agreed that Rina and Ingrid will produce a proposition and present that to WP leaders.

EFGS 2020 situation

Amelia brought out that the EFGS steering committee has discussed about the risks covid-19 causes on face-to-face events. The committee decided that the EFGS 2020 conference will be held only as a webinar. The planning has started, and it is yet to be discussed should the conference be shortened to two days. When the structure for the webinar is planned, the steering committee will approve it.

This change will require an official amendment to the project plan.

WP3

The fast track task has been started and a meeting for next week is organized. It was agreed that all documents, even the drafts will be stored in the WP3 workspace in Teams.

The conference 2020 was already discussed in the item Announcements. About the conference 2021 Hanna pointed out that the venue is chosen.
