EFGS CURRENT WORK PROGRAMME

- Development of the best practices in the production of geostatistics in Europe.
- Development of partnership between NSIs and NMCAs on equal terms.
- A fully geocoded 2021 population and housing census.
- Completion of the GSGF Europe and support its implementation in the organisations (on going GEOSTAT 4 project).
- Organizing annual EFGS conferences strengthening the importance of statistical and geospatial integration and cross-domain collaboration.



EFGS CHALLENGES

- Supporting Eurostat and NSIs for a fully geocoded 2021 population and housing census.
- Works on cooperation and common approach to linking statistical data with geospatial information with UN-GGIM Europe, UNECE and Eurogeographics
- Statistical-geospatial information system for sustainable development
- Finalise the methodological work on the GSGF for Europe and encourage Member States to implement the framework.
- Harmonization a statistical reference system with a geodetic reference system on the base of Global Statistical Geospatial Framework and "The 10 Level Model".



EFGS CHALLENGES (cont.)

- Need for a cross-domain co-ordinated collaboration and organisation in dealing with statistical geospatial information.
- COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING REGULATION (EU) 2018/1799 of 21
 November 2018 on the establishment of a temporary direct statistical
 action for the dissemination of selected topics of the 2021 population
 and housing census geocoded to a 1 km2 grid.
- New data sources and tools.
- Open data policy.
- Harmonised protection of census data in the ESS deliverables of the ESS project.
- Further debate on grids in European and global perspective.


