

## Green and open spaces for all in European cities?

### Assessing SDG indicator 11.7.1 in European and national organisations: a synthesis prepared within the UN-GGIM: Europe Line of Work on SDG Indicators.

#### Abstract

One of the ongoing UN-GGIM: Europe Lines of Work deals with Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) and more specifically aims to provide guidance on the calculation of SDG indicators, benefiting from the use of geodata and spatial analysis.

A recent UN-GGIM: Europe survey has identified a shortlist of indicators that are considered of particular interest to national organisations dealing with integrated geospatial and statistical information. Indicator 11.7.1, which assesses the availability of open urban spaces fit for public use, features among the selected indicators.

Several national and European organisations have worked towards the operationalisation of the indicator and have explored ways to enhance the indicator framework by adding additional metrics.

This presentation will describe recent developments and findings collected by several organisations. The aim is to provide an overview of the state of play regarding the calculation of the indicators related to target 11.7 and prepare the ground for a more in-depth exchange of experiences that is planned to take place within the work of UN-GGIM: Europe.
